- Class H9 B.S.P.S Heritage Open Mixed Height Working Hunter Pony**
Open to Pure Bred Registered ponies, four years and over stallion, mare or gelding. Riders any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section.
Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.
- Class H10 Unaffiliated Working Hunter Pony Training Stakes (No Conformation)**
Open to plaited and un-plaited ponies, four years old or over. Rider's any age.
Maximum height of fences 80cms.
Competitors will be required to jump a course of fences and immediately give a short show including a change of rein and a gallop in the same ring.
- Class H11 B.S.P.S Mixed Height Open Working Hunter Pony / Intermediate Working Hunter**
Open to mare or gelding, four years old and over not exceeding 158cms.
Riders must jump in their correct section and must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section. Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms or the Intermediate section.

Mare or Gelding, four years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached by the noseband only. Rosettes to all entries
